A deposit must be made in order to reserve a stateroom and to receive confirmation by email.

Deposit requirements are the same regardless of the number of stateroom occupants, unless otherwise noted. The minimum deposit amount must be received no later than seven (7) days after booking, varying based on time prior to departure.

Select fare programs require the payment at the time of booking of a nonrefundable deposit. That deposit amount shall not be refunded at any time after it has been paid. Change fees will apply to bookings for which the deposit is nonrefundable.

Final payment of the balance must be received at Royal Caribbean® offices at least 60 days prior to the sailing date for sailings 5 nights or less and 75 days prior to sailing date for sailings 6 nights or more. Holiday sailings require final payment 90 days prior to the sailing date. (The payment schedule for groups is different from that for individuals. Please consult your travel agent for details.)

## How Should I Pay?

If you booked your cruise through your travel agency, provide payment to your travel agent. Travel agents: Make checks payable to Royal Caribbean Cruises Ltd, P.O. Box 025511, Miami, FL 33102-5511. For Express Mail or courier deliveries, send to Royal Caribbean Cruises Ltd, 1050 Caribbean Way, Miami, FL 33132, Attn: Cash Processing Department. If you booked your cruise directly with Royal Caribbean®, you may pay us via credit card, money order or personal check. Royal Caribbean® accepts Visa®, MasterCard®, American Express®, Optima®, Diners Club International® and Discover® cards for individual bookings.

## If I Have To Cancel My Cruise, Cruisetour Or Hotel Stay, Will I Receive A Refund?

You'll receive a full refund if you notify us in writing 75 days (90 days for 5 nights or longer and holiday sailings) prior to your departure date (except for Nonrefundable Deposit

amounts.) Cancellations must be made by the guest or his/her travel agent. Depending on when the cruise is cancelled, a cancellation charge may apply. See chart for applicable late-cancellation charges for cruises. Consult your travel agent for applicable late-cancellation charges for single, third and fourth guests, and holiday sailings. (Cancellation charges for groups differ from those for individuals. Please consult your travel agent for details.)

Travel agents may impose their own charges in connection with a cruise. For example, the travel agent may charge a flat service fee for assistance with your reservations and a value-added charge for additional amenities or services being provided by the travel agent. In addition, travel agents may impose their own cancellation fees.

Any charges or fees of this nature are a matter strictly between the guest and their travel agent. Cancellation coverage is available when you purchase our Royal Caribbean Travel Protection Program. ## Can I Join My Cruise After It Starts Or Disembark Before It Ends?

It depends on the specific itinerary of your cruise, your nationality, and various United States and foreign laws. Joining the cruise at one of its ports of call or leaving the cruise prior to its scheduled termination point may be prohibited by law. If you need to join late or leave early, or both, submit your request in advance and we will tell you whether your proposed changes will be permitted. There is a cut-off date for submitting this information, so make your request early. Please note that no refunds, prorated or otherwise, are granted to customers who join their cruise late or leave their cruise early. Certain governments impose fines or other charges when a guest permanently disembarks from a cruise before its final port of call. The guest will be responsible for those charges.

## Will The Price Change?

Royal Caribbean International® reserves the right to change, whether via an increase or decrease, any published rates, including cruise rates and airfare charges, without prior notice. We reserve the right to impose on any existing booking or new bookings (whether paid in full or not) a supplement for fuel or other matters without prior notice as provided in our Passenger Ticket Contract, which appears at [RoyalCaribbean.com/cruiseticketcontract](http://RoyalCaribbean.com/cruiseticketcontract)

In addition, we reserve the right to pass through any third-party-imposed fuel or other surcharges, also without prior notice. The guest will remain liable for any applicable taxes, fees or surcharges that may be assessed by any governmental or quasi-governmental agencies. Such assessment is subject to change without notice at any time whether or not you have a confirmed booking under deposit or if you have made final payment.

**Service Fees:** Any changes or cancellations to your cruise/ Cruisetour or Air Arrangements (to which a cancellation charge does not apply) may be subject to additional fees such as service fees for documents.

## What Does The Cruise Price Include?

The price of your cruise vacation includes accommodations, most dining options, nightly entertainment and most onboard activities. Prices are cruise-only, per person, based on double occupancy in U.S. dollars and vary based on date of reservation, sailing date and stateroom category. Prices are subject to change without notice.

The cruise vacation price does not include air transportation (except as noted); transfers (except as noted); optional shore and land excursions; meals and accommodations ashore (except as noted); certain beverages; casino gaming; photographs; gratuities; internet, in-room telephone calls; specialty restaurants; purchases from ship stores; or items of a personal nature such as medical services, laundry, spa treatments or salon services. Some of these items may be purchased separately.

## What Does The Cruisetour Price Include?

The Cruisetour price includes the standard cruise components plus all transportation, hotels, transfers and sightseeing as indicated in this brochure. Meals on the land portion of the tour are not included except as indicated.

The cruise/Cruisetour fares quoted also do not include any applicable government taxes, fees or surcharges that may be assessed by any governmental or quasi-governmental agencies. Such assessment is subject to change without notice at any time, whether or not you have a confirmed booking under deposit or if you have made final payment.

## What If I Am Traveling With A Group?

The terms and conditions set forth in this brochure in general apply to persons traveling as a part of a group booking. However, some policies—such as deposit, payment, cancellations and other matters—set forth in this brochure do not apply to group bookings. Consult your travel professional for more details.

## When Will My Cruise Documents Be Available?

Assuming all cruise elements are finalized and payments made, cruise documents will be available electronically from your travel agent or at [RoyalCaribbean.com](http://RoyalCaribbean.com) as early as 48 days prior to sailing. All cruise tickets and air arrangements are valid only for the named passenger and may not be sold or transferred. Regardless of document status, no one will be allowed passage unless his or her name appears on the ship's guest manifest.

## Do I Need A Passport?\*

Yes, but there are some exceptions for U.S. citizens sailing on certain domestic voyages. Please see below for details. Before leaving home, please take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with the required travel documents you will be asked to provide prior to boarding the ship.

Caution: The requirements described below are government regulations and policies. They are subject to change without notice. It is the sole responsibility of the guest to identify and obtain all required travel documents and have them available when necessary. These appropriate valid travel documents, such as passport, visas, inoculation certificate and family legal documents, are required for boarding and reentry into the United States and other countries. For your protection, we recommend that your passport book expiration date not occur within six (6) months following the voyage termination date.

The name on your cruise line or airline reservation must match the name on your passport book or other identification documents.

Guests who do not possess the proper documentation may be prevented from boarding their flight or ship or from entering a country and may be subject to fines.

**No refunds will be given to individuals who fail to bring proper documentation.**

## Consecutive Sailings

Guests on consecutive sailings must ensure they have the proper travel documents for their cruise vacation.

## Domestic Travel Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI)

The Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI) requires all travelers to and from the United States, Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and Bermuda to present a valid passport book or other Department of Homeland Security-approved document that establishes the bearer's identity and citizenship in order to enter or reenter the United States, unless otherwise noted below. ## WHTI-Compliant Documents

A valid passport book is already a requirement for international travel and for entering the United States by air.

## Cruise Travel

### Open-Loop Sailings

An open-loop cruise (voyages that begin in one U.S. port and end in another U.S. port) will require a valid passport book or other WHTI-compliant document for entry or reentry into the United States.

### Closed-Loop Sailings

Only a valid passport book or other WHTI-compliant document will be accepted for entry or reentry into the United States.

U.S. citizens on closed-loop cruises (cruises that begin and end or depart at the same U.S. port), will be able to enter or depart the U.S. with proof of citizenship such as a government-issued birth certificate and laminated government-issued picture I.D. denoting photo, name and date of birth. A U.S. citizen under the age of 16 will be able to present either an original, notarized or certified copy of his or her birth certificate, a Consular Report of Birth Abroad issued by DOS, or Certificate of Naturalization issued by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services. In the absence of any of the documents listed above, guests will be required to present BOTH an identification and citizenship document from each of the lists below in order to embark our vessel. The name on both documents needs to match the name on the cruise line reservation. If it does not as a result of marriage or divorce, guests will need to provide their state-, county- or province-issued marriage license or divorce decree. Guests who legally change their name will need to present a court document.

### Closed-Loop Identification Documents

- Laminated driver's license or identification card issued by a federal, state, provincial, country, territory or municipal authority

- All identification documents must have a photo, name and date of birth

### Closed-Loop Citizenship Documents\*\*

Government-issued:

- U.S. Birth Certificate (original)
- U.S. Birth Abroad Certificate (original)
- U.S. Naturalization Certificate (original)
- U.S. Certificate of Citizenship (original)

Exception: If your ship's itinerary includes a call to Cuba, all guests are required to have a valid passport that is valid for at least 6 months after the cruise.

## International Travel

A valid passport book is required; visas are required where they apply. This includes Europe, Asia, and Australia/New Zealand. For additional passport information visit:

## Our Recommendation

Royal Caribbean International® strongly recommends that all guests travel with a valid passport book during their cruise. This greatly assists guests who may need to fly out of the United States to meet their ship at the next available port should they miss their scheduled embarkation in a U.S. port; guests entering the U.S. at the end of their cruise; and guests needing to fly to the U.S. before their cruise ends because of medical, family, personal or business emergencies, missing a ship's departure from a port-of-call, involuntary disembarkation from a ship due to misconduct, or other reasons. Guests who need to fly to the United States before their cruise ends will likely experience significant delays and complications related to booking airline tickets and entering the United States if they do not have a valid U.S. passport book with them. ## Non-U.S. Citizens

You will need a valid passport book and, in some cases, a visa. If you live in the U.S., you will also need the original copy of your Alien Registration Card (ARC or "Green Card") and any other documentation the countries on your itinerary require due to your alien status.

## Canadian Landed Immigrants

All Canadian Landed Immigrants (inclusive of those who are citizens of the British Commonwealth countries) who reside in Canada must have valid passport and U.S. visas. Also required is the original copy of your Permanent Resident Card (PR Card), formerly the IMM 1000, or with respect to any country on the itinerary, any other travel documentation required because of alien status.

For voyages that begin and end in the same U.S. port, U.S. citizens guests may travel with both a Government-issued birth certificate\*\* and Government issued picture ID card, such as a drivers' license.

## Alien Registration Card (Green Card)

U.S. lawful permanent residents will continue to be able to use their Alien Registration Card issued by the Department of Homeland Security or other valid evidence of permanent residence status to apply for entry to the United States.

Card renewal is an important matter. ARC holders (United States permanent residents) with expired cards may be considered "out of status" and may be denied entry/reentry into the United States. If your ARC was issued over 10 years ago, you should check the expiration date printed on the front of the card. If your card is expired or it is about to expire, you should renew your card before you sail. If you are holding an old-edition ARC WITHOUT an expiration date, you will not be detained from entering the United States, but U.S. Customs and Border Protection highly suggests that you apply for a new card before you sail. ## Visa

For specific visa requirements, information, forms and fees for your nationality, please contact the Embassy (Consular Services) of each country on your sailing itinerary or a visa service provider such as CIBT at [www.cibt.com/rci](http://www.cibt.com/rci) or 1-800-858-8579 (identify yourself as a Royal Caribbean® guest for discounted rates).

## Visa Waiver Program

This is a pre-travel authorization program for U.S.-bound travelers from Visa Waiver countries. This U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) program, the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) is mandatory, and all travelers, regardless of age, from Visa Waiver Program (VWP) countries will be required to complete an online application similar to the I-94W and obtain an ESTA approval prior to boarding a carrier by air or sea to the United States under the VWP. A third party, such as a relative or travel agent, will be permitted to submit an ESTA application on behalf of a VWP traveler. The DHS recommends that an ESTA approval be obtained as soon as a VWP traveler begins to plan a trip to the United States and no later than 72 hours before departure. Should the information you provided change after receiving your approval, updating your application online is easy.

ESTA will determine almost immediately in many cases if

an individual is eligible for VWP travel. Possible website responses include: Authorization Approved, Travel Not Approved, or Authorization Pending. In the event that an ESTA applicant is denied authorization to travel to the United States under VWP, he or she will be referred to U.S. Department of State website for information on how to apply for a visa to travel to the United States. Applicants who receive an Authorization Pending response will need to check the website for updates within 72 hours to receive a final response.

An approved ESTA travel authorization is:

- valid for up to two years or until the traveler's passport book expires, whichever comes first;
- valid for multiple entries into the U.S. be it for business or pleasure; and
- not a guarantee of admissibility to the United States at a port of entry. ESTA approval only authorizes a traveler to board a carrier for travel to the U.S. under VWP. In all cases, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officers make admissibility determinations at U.S. ports of entry. (For additional information please visit "Know Before You Go" at the [CBP.gov](http://CBP.gov) website.)

Guests who apply electronically will be required to present their ESTA authorization approval receipt in order to board the vessel on applicable voyages.

## Countries Participating In The Visa Waiver Program

Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, The Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and United Kingdom. Travelers from the VWP countries seeking to enter the United States will also be required to have a passport book in their possession. ## Pre-Travel Authorization Program for U.S.-Bound Travelers from Visa Waiver Countries

This U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) program has a mandatory effective date of January 12, 2009. On this date, subject to DHS modification, the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) became mandatory, and all travelers, regardless of age, from Visa Waiver Program (VWP) countries will be required to complete an online application similar to the I-94W and obtain an ESTA approval prior to boarding a carrier by air or sea to the United States under the VWP. ESTA website: <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov>

## Inoculation/Health

As detailed in our brochure, all guests must ensure they are medically fit for travel. As such, we remind you to check with your physician at least 4 to 6 weeks before sailing to make sure you are up to date with any required immunizations or vaccines you may need (including but not limited to certification of yellow fever vaccination) to ensure you will be permitted to visit each of the exciting destinations and tours on your itinerary.

## Family Legal Documents

Should the last names of the parent sailing with their minor child differ, the parent is required to present the child's valid passport book and visa (if required) and the child's birth certificate (original, a notarized copy or a certified copy). The name of the parent(s) and the child must be linked through legal documentation. Adults who are not the parent or legal guardian of any minor child traveling with them are required to present the child's valid passport and visa (if required) or the child's birth certificate (original, a notarized copy or a certified copy) and an original notarized letter signed by at least one of the child's parents. The notarized letter from the child's parent must authorize the traveling adult to take the child on the specific cruise and must authorize the traveling adult to supervise the child and permit any medical treatment that must be administered to the child. If a non-parent adult is a legal guardian, the adult must present a certified Certificate of Guardianship with respect to the child.

\*\*A "birth certificate" is issued by a government agency (state, county, city, etc.). This document (with seal and signature) is legal proof of citizenship that can be used by U.S. citizens for certain international travel. A "birth notice" is issued by a hospital or other type of medical facility but it is not an approved travel document; it is a courtesy document that merely indicates where a birth occurred. It has no legal status and cannot be used to prove citizenship for international travel purposes. Therefore, please note baptismal papers and hospital certificates are NOT acceptable. Additionally, voter registration cards or Social Security cards are NOT considered proof of citizenship.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

## What Are The Gratuity Guidelines For Cruises?

Royal Caribbean's onboard staff and crew await our guests with personalized Royal Way service®. Royal Caribbean® will add a daily US\$13.50 gratuity (US\$16.50 for suite guests) to each guest's onboard SeaPass® account. The gratuities will be shared by the Dining Services Staff (waiter, assistant waiter and head waiter), Stateroom Attendants and Other Housekeeping Services Personnel who work to enhance your cruise. Alternatively, guests may prepay gratuities prior to boarding by calling Royal Caribbean® or your travel agent. Guests who prepay gratuities will not have an automatic daily gratuity added to their SeaPass® account.

An 18% gratuity is also automatically added to beverages, mini-bar items, spa & salon purchases. Many of our guests wish to reward exceptional service during their cruise by providing additional gratuities. Guests may do so by providing an additional gratuity to their SeaPass® onboard account or a cash gratuity at their discretion.

## What Are The Gratuity Guidelines For Cruisetours?

- *Alaska Adventure Specialist: US\$3.50 a day, per guest*
- *Alaska Traincar Host: US\$1.00 a day, per guest*

## Does The Name On My Reservation Need To Match The Name On My Passport?

Yes. It is important that the name on your reservation be exactly as it is stated on your passport or other official proof of nationality. If your name has changed since your document was issued (e.g., marriage/divorce), it is required that you update the document with the new name or provide an official supporting document of the name change (e.g., marriage certificate). Otherwise, it may result in delay or possible denial of boarding.

## What About Guests With Disabilities?

Royal Caribbean International® welcomes guests with disabilities and works hard to assist them throughout their vacation. Guests should ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger their well-being or the well-being of others. Our personnel are not required to perform personal tasks (e.g., assisting with eating, dressing, toileting or lifting); therefore, guests who require assistance with these functions should consider these needs when making a booking. If there is a question regarding the guest's fitness to travel without personal assistance, this must be discussed with our Access Department.

While we do not require information about your disability, the more information you can share with us about your specific needs, the better we will be able to assist you. We encourage you to notify us of your needs at the time of booking; however, to guarantee availability of specific equipment or services, please provide:

- 60 days' advance notice for sign language interpreting services
- 30 days' advance notice for special equipment or services

Guests with medical concerns are advised to check with their physician before sailing. Tendering may preclude guests from going ashore at certain ports of call.

Alaska Cruisetours are accessible; however, other Cruisetours cannot accommodate full-time wheelchair users. Please contact the Access department to notify us of your accommodation needs.

**Designated Staterooms:** Accessible staterooms are offered on all Royal Caribbean ships in different

categories. They are designed for guests with mobility disabilities and other disabilities that require the use of the accessible features of the staterooms. Accessible staterooms are held for people with disabilities until all other non-accessible staterooms in that category are reserved. Upon reserving an accessible stateroom, we require our guests to acknowledge in writing the need for an accessible stateroom by completing a Guest Special Needs Form. This form may be filled out online at [RoyalCaribbean.com/specialneedsform](https://www.royalcaribbean.com/specialneedsform). Guests without a disability booked in an accessible stateroom may be moved at any time to accommodate a guest with a disability.

**Assistive Devices:** Guests may bring and use onboard wheelchairs, mobility scooters and other assistive devices. Due to safety reasons, a Segway® may not be used on board. Assistive devices, including mobility scooters, must be stored and recharged in staterooms so fire doors, corridors and elevator lobbies are kept clear for emergency evacuation. When parked throughout the ship, they must be parked out of the way to allow safe and easy access by other guests and crew members. Assistive devices should fit through a standard stateroom entry doorway which is at least 23 inches wide. We offer accessible staterooms with wider doors which are at least 32 inches wide and may accommodate larger devices. Crew members are not permitted to lift assistive devices.

**Oxygen:** Guests dependent on oxygen or requiring oxygen therapy must notify the Access Department prior to boarding the ship.

**Pregnancy:** Royal Caribbean® will not accept guests who will enter their 24th week of pregnancy by the beginning, or any time during the cruise or Cruisetour. All guests are required to sign a health questionnaire at check-in to ensure they are aware of our pregnancy policy. **Infant Policy:** Infants sailing on a cruise must be at least 6 months old as of the first day of the cruise/Cruisetour. For transatlantic, transpacific, Hawaii and other selected cruises/Cruisetours, the child must be at least 12 months old as of the first day of the cruise. Any Cruisetours associated with these cruises are also subject to the 12-month minimum age requirement. Denial of boarding for infants who do not satisfy these minimum age requirements may also result in the denial of boarding for one or more guests sailing with that infant. No refunds or other compensation shall be due from the cruise line to anyone as a result of the denial of boarding to an underage infant or other accompanying guests.

**Onboard Physicians:** Each Royal Caribbean® vessel is equipped with a medical facility. At least one licensed physician and two nurses are normally in attendance on all cruises. Guests will be charged for medical services, and medications are available on board for a fee. The types of medications kept on board are limited, and guests must bring an adequate supply of any specific medications they need. The medical facility is not intended or designed to serve as a clinic for guests, and Royal Caribbean® is not responsible for the diagnosis, treatment or services furnished by shipboard medical personnel.

## What About Advanced Or Delayed Sailings And Changes In Itinerary?

In the event of strikes, lockouts, riots, weather conditions or mechanical difficulties, or for any other reason whatsoever, Royal Caribbean® may, at any time and without prior notice, cancel, advance, postpone

or deviate from any scheduled sailing or port of call and may, but is not obliged to, substitute another ship or port of call and shall not be liable for any loss whatsoever to guests by reason of such cancellation, advancement, postponement, deviation or substitution. Royal Caribbean® shall not be responsible for any failure to adhere to the arrival and departure times published in this brochure for any of its ports of call.

While every effort will be made to adhere to the specifics shown herein for a cruise, circumstances may necessitate changes or deviations therefrom. All schedules, itinerary destinations, hours of arrival and departure, hotel and/or conveyances and other aspects of Cruisetour programs are subject to change without prior notice. Neither Royal Caribbean® nor any affiliated party shall be required to refund any portion of fare or other charges or make any compensation under these circumstances.

## How Are Disputes Settled?

Any dispute between a guest and Royal Caribbean® in connection with a guest's cruise booking or cruise vacation shall be litigated, if at all, in and before a court located in Miami, Florida, USA, to the exclusion of the courts of any other state, territory or country.

## Can Passage Or A Booking Request Be Refused?

To facilitate our ability to continue to provide safe and enjoyable cruises to our guests, we reserve the right to refuse to accept a booking request from an individual or group and reserve the right to cancel an existing reservation.
